## HELP STOP OUT-OF-CONTROL USE OF FORCE BY PASADENA POLICE

Chris Ballew's beating by Pasadena police should never happen to anyone.

Here are some changes to police department policy/rules that can prevent brutal, excessive use of force by Pasadena police.

- 1) Require officers to give more time and space to interactions with people that may lead to violence.
- 2) Give clear guidelines to officers about use of force necessary in different situations. Don't leave it up to the officer at all times.
- 3) Prohibit dangerous uses of force like carotid control/chokeholds and shooting at moving vehicles.

Preventing police misconduct is better than cleaning up the damage afterwards. Citizens must have a place at the table to reform police conduct.
